# GRAND TOUR OF ICELAND

## 12 DAYS - 11 NIGHTS

### 2026 DEPARTURES

May 18; Jun. 1, 15, 29; Jul. 13, 27; Aug. 10, 24

This Iceland itinerary offers a rich journey through the country's most spectacular natural landscapes and cultural highlights. Starting in Reykjavík, travelers visit Þingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site where tectonic plates meet, and continue through scenic countryside shaped by volcanic and glacial activity.

The route follows Iceland's dramatic South Coast, featuring iconic waterfalls such as Seljalandsfoss, Skógafoss, and Dettifoss, along with black-sand beaches, glacier lagoons, and Vatnajökull National Park. The journey also includes the Lake Mývatn region with its geothermal areas, volcanic landscapes, and nearby towns and fishing villages that showcase local life.

The tour concludes with the famous Golden Circle, including Gullfoss waterfall, the Geysir geothermal area, and Þingvellir, before returning to Reykjavík. This itinerary delivers an unforgettable introduction to Iceland's powerful natural beauty and unique geological wonders.

## DAY 1: ARRIVAL

Individual transfer by Flybus from Keflavik airport to Reykjavik. Explore capital city.

## DAY 2: ÞINGVELLIR & SNÆFELLSNES PENINSULA (B, D)

The tour visits Þingvellir National Park (a UNESCO site). Continue to the Snæfellsnes Peninsula National Park to view the Snæfellsjökull glacier, with an option to descend into the Vatnshellir lava cave.

## DAY 3: FERRY TRIP TO WEST FJORDS & DYNJANDI WATERFALL (B, D)

Transfer from Stykkishólmur to Brjánslækur by ferry, crossing Breiðafjörður Bay. The journey continues over mountains until the majestic fjord Arnarfjörður, culminating at Dynjandi waterfall.

## DAY 4: ICELAND'S WESTERNMOST POINT (B, D)

The group stops at the Hnjótur museum and then walks the Látrabjarg bird cliffs. If weather conditions allow, there is an option to visit Rauðisandur beach.

## DAY 5: WESTFJORDS TO NORTHWEST ICELAND (B, D)

The journey departs the Westfjords, traveling east through changing landscapes to Northwest Iceland. The group stops at the Erpsstaðir dairy farm.

## DAY 6: HEADING NORTH (B, D)

Circle around the Vatnsnes Peninsula passing Hvammstangi, to see the Hvítserkur sea stack. Visit the preserved Víðimýri turf church and the Glaumbær turf farm museum before continuing to Akureyri, the capital of North Iceland.

## DAY 7: ICELAND'S NORTHERNMOST TOWN, WHALE WATCHING & SEA ANGLING (B)

After enjoying the Akureyri botanical garden, the group takes a whale watching tour in Eyjafjörður. Travel to Siglufjörður to visit the Herring Era Museum.

## DAY 8: VOLCANIC LAVA WONDERS AND GEOTHERMAL BATHING (B, D)

Explore Goðafoss and the Lake Mývatn area, Dimmuborgir, Hverfjall, and the Námaskarð hot springs. After, see Dettifoss waterfall before soaking in the Vök baths geothermal floating pool.

## DAY 9: EAST FJORDS (B, D)

Take a visit to Petra's unique rock and mineral collection and viewing Vatnajökull, Europe's biggest glacier visible all-over Southeast Iceland.

## DAY 10: VATNAJÖKULL NATIONAL PARK, GLACIER LAGOON & BLACK SAND BEACH (B, D)

The tour visits Vatnajökull National Park for a boat tour on the Jökulsárlón glacial lagoon and a walk on Diamond Beach. Continue to Skaftafell region before concluding at Reynisfjara Black Sand beach.

## DAY 11: THE SOUTH COAST & GOLDEN CIRCLE (B, D)

Travel South Coast of Iceland; visit Skógafoss and Seljalandsfoss waterfalls. Visit Volcano Exhibition Centre then head back to the Golden Circle. Stopping first at Friðheimar. Explore Gullfoss then visit Geysir to see Strokkur "The Churn".

## DAY 12: DEPARTURE (B)

Flybus transfer from Reykjavik to Keflavik International Airport.

## INCLUSIONS:

- Airport arrival & departure transfer by Flybus Shuttle (no guide).
- Eleven (11) nights hotel accommodation.
- 7x breakfast + 9 (3-course) dinner.
- 10 days escorted bus tour with English-speaking guide/driver-guide.
- Discover three national parks. Lava cave in Snæfellsnes.
- Ferry trip to the West Fjords.
- Entrance to Folk and transport museum at Hnjótur.
- Farm visit at Erpsstaðir.
- Entrance to Glaumbær Museum & Víðimýri Turf Church.
- Herring museum.
- Whale watching tour in Eyjafjörður fjord.
- Vök Baths, including towel.
- Petra's stone collection.
- Boat trip on Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon.
- Exhibition and 4K movie at Lava Centre in Hvolsvöllur.
- Visit to a geothermal greenhouse and horse stables.
