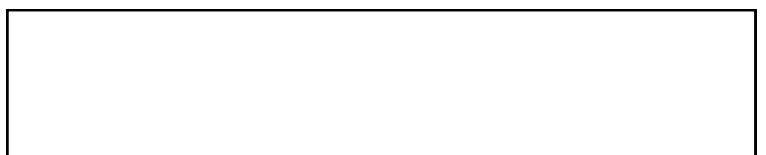

DAY 1 - ARRIVAL ISTANBUL

Arrival in Athens. Our transfer will be waiting for you at the airport to take you to your hotel.

DAY 2 - ISTANBUL OLD CITY (B)

Tour the exotic city that spans both Europe and Asia visiting the Topkapi Palace, Blue Mosque, St Sophia Museum and the Hippodrome.

DAY 3 - ISTANBUL BOSPHOROUS CRUISE (B, D)

Cruise between two continents by public ferry. Afterwards take a flight to Cappadocia, upon arrival you will be transferred to your hotel. The remainder of the day is free time to explore.

DAY 4 - CAPPADOCIA, GOREME, UNDERGROUND CITY (B, D)

Visit the Goreme Valley Open Air Museum. Tonight, don't miss the optional Turkish folklore evening featuring folklore and belly dancers.

DAY 5 - SULTANHANI CARAVANSARY, KONYA (B, D)

Visit the mausoleum of Mevlana Celaleddin Rumi, the great 13th-century Sufi mystic and poet. Travel along the legendary Silk Road, visit the Çatalhöyük Museum.

DAY 6 - PAMUKKALE, HIERAPOLIS (B, D)

Today we head for Pamukkale and its calcium travertines. Visit the ruins of Hierapolis, the Temple of Apollo, Necropolis, and stroll over the magnificent white calcium terraces of Pamukkale.

DAY 7 - LAODICEA, KUSADASI (B, D)

Explore Laodicea ancient city which was the chief city of the Lycus River Valley region.

DAY 8 - EPHEBUS, ATHENS (B)

Tour the Ephesus and a visit to the Temple of Artemis. Visit a carpet village where we learn how the carpets are made by hand. After, you will drive to Izmir Airport for a flight to Athens.

DAY 9 - ATHENS (B)

Today you are free to explore Athens at your own pace.

DAY 10 - ATHENS (B)

The tour starts from the Panathenaic Stadium. Continue by the Temple of Olympian Zeus, the Hadrian's Arch, the Parliament and the memorial to the Unknown Soldier, the Academy, the University, the National Library, the Syntagma. On the Acropolis visit, the Architectural Masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: The Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion and finally the Parthenon.

DAY 11 - ATHENS, CORINTH CANAL, MYCENAE, NAFPLION (B)

Depart early and cross the Corinth Canal. Next stop will be a visit at the famous Mycenae, (UNESCO). Depart for Nafplion, the first capital of Greece in Argolis.

DAY 12 - OLYMPIA, DELPHI (B, D)

Early departure for Olympia. Visit the archeological site of Ancient Olympia, Sanctuary of Olympian Zeus, the Ancient Stadium and the Archaeological Museum. In the afternoon journey to the north, over the Rio-Antirio Bridge, and to Delphi.

DAY 13 - DELPHI, KALAMBAKA (B, D)

Visit at Delphi. See the well-preserved remains of Temple Apollo, the Castalian Spring and Temple of Athena, the Oracle of Delphi. Afterwards, proceed to Kalambaka.

DAY 14 - METEORA, ATHENS (B)

Visit Meteora, unique rock formations, rising high, stand ageless Christian Monasteries among striking scenery. Return to Athens via Trikala, Lamia, Thermopylae.

DAY 15 - ATHENS DEPARTURE (B)

After breakfast, your tour concludes and we say goodbye to our new friends.

INCLUSIONS:

- Fourteen (14) nights accommodation at listed hotels or similar.
- Fourteen (14) breakfasts + eight (8) dinners.
- Airport arrival transfer in Istanbul and departure transfer in Athens.
- Bosphorous cruise.
- Domestic flight between Istanbul and Cappadocia including transfers.
- Transportation in a fully air-conditioned, non-smoking vehicle.
- Tours and entrance fees as specified in the itinerary.
- Services of a professional English-speaking tour guide.

EXCLUSIONS:

- International tickets (Manila-Istanbul/Athens-Manila and between Izmir & Athens)
- Visa processing fees.
- Compulsory travel insurance.
- Suggested optional activities.
- Greece - Hotel Residence Tax. (See notes below.)

- All other expenses not mentioned as included in the program.

NOTES:

1. The minimum group size for this tour is 2 passengers and a maximum group size of 20 passengers for the Turkey segment and 50 passengers for the Greece segment.
2. The minimum age to join this tour is 8 years old. While there is no maximum age set, it is assumed the customer is fit enough to take part in the activity or tour. Health documents may be requested.
3. Meteora Dress Code: The monasteries have a strict dress code. To enter the monasteries of Meteora you have to adhere to the following rules: Women will need to wear a long skirt, dress or sarong, it's not enough to keep the knees covered, so no trousers or shorts. Men must wear long pants. Sleeveless shirts are not allowed. Please make sure to have appropriate clothing before visiting the monasteries.
4. This tour is rated as Moderate, meaning it involves some walking, stairs, and longer travel days, and is suitable for travelers with a reasonable level of fitness.
