Journey to the poignant Gallipoli battlefields and unravel the myths of ancient Troy and the charming village of Behramkale. Discover the grandeur of Ephesus, one of the best-preserved ancient cities, and marvel at Pamukkale's stunning white calcium terraces, enjoying its therapeutic hot springs. This captivating tour seamlessly blends deep historical insights with breathtaking natural beauty, culminating back in vibrant Istanbul.

DAY 1: ARRIVAL ISTANBUL

Welcome to Istanbul! You will be transferred to your hotel and the remainder of the day is yours, free to explore.

DAY 2: ISTANBUL OLD CITY (B)

After breakfast, you enjoy a fully guided tour of the only city to span two continents, visiting the Blue Mosque, St Sophia Museum, Topkapi Palace (including Hagia Irene and the Harem) and the Hippodrome.

DAY 3: GALLIPOLI BATTLEFIELDS (B, D)

One of the most emotionally touching places in Turkey, today we visit the WW1 Battlefields of Gallipoli including Lone Pine and Chunuk Bair Memorials, ANZAC Cove, The Nek, Johnston's Jolly, original trenches and tunnels.

DAY 4: TROY, BEHRAMKALE, KUSADASI (B, D)

Depart from Çanakkale and head towards Troy, where we will explore the ancient city, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the new, award-winning Troy Museum. We continue on to the old village of Behramkale, a picturesque settlement with stone houses and narrow streets that offer a glimpse into traditional Turkish village life. You will have time to explore the village, take in the beautiful scenery, and perhaps enjoy a cup of Turkish tea or coffee at a local café. From Behramkale, we head south to Kuşadası.

DAY 5: EPHEBUS, KUSADASI (B, D)

Absorb yourself in history today with a guided tour of Ephesus and a visit to the site of the Temple of Artemis. Feel the mystical atmosphere of the ancient city and theatre before exploring the Ephesus Archaeology Museum, which houses an impressive collection of artifacts from the region. Carpet weaving has long traditions in Turkey, and at the carpet village, we learn how the carpets are made by hand and what determines their value.

DAY 6: PAMUKKALE, HIERAPOLIS (B, D)

This morning we will enjoy a display of locally handcrafted leather goods before heading to the magnificent white calcium terraces, known as Travertines, in Pamukkale where we also tour the ancient city of Hierapolis. Take a dip, amongst ancient columns, in the hot springs that were used in Roman times for their therapeutic powers..

DAY 7: ISTANBUL (B, D)

Today you head back to Istanbul. You will be transferred to the airport for your flight and be back in Istanbul, where you will be met and transferred to your hotel in time for a bit of last minute shopping or exploring.

DAY 8: DEPARTURE ISTANBUL (B, D)

After breakfast our tour concludes and we say goodbye to our new friends and are transferred to the airport for your onward flight.

INCLUSIONS:

- Seven (7) night accommodation at listed hotels or similar.
- Seven (7) breakfast + four (4) dinners.
- Airport arrival and departure transfers. (Available upon the start of services for inbound transfers and the final day of tour for outbound transfers).
- Transportation in a fully air-conditioned, non-smoking vehicle.
- Domestic flight between Denizli and Istanbul and transfers.
- Tours and entrance fees as specified in the itinerary.
- Services of a professional English-speaking tour guide throughout the journey.

- International tickets.
- Visa processing fees.
- Compulsory travel insurance.
- Suggested optional activities.
- Tips to driver and guide.
- All other expenses not mentioned as included in the program.

NOTES:

1. The minimum group size for this tour is 2 passengers and a maximum group size of 20 passengers.
