# LISBON, FATIMA, PORTO & SANTIAGO COMPOSTELA



## 9 DAYS - 8 NIGHTS

Discover the best of central and northern Portugal and northern Spain: Lisbon, Cascais, Sintra, Óbidos, Nazaré, Alcobaça, Fátima, Aljustrel, Coimbra, Porto, Santiago de Compostela, and Combarro.

**DAY 1 (FRI): ARRIVAL LISBON**

Arrival at Lisbon airport and transfer to the hotel. Free time to rest or explore on your own. Overnight stay in Lisbon.

**DAY 2 (SAT): LISBON – BELÉM – CASCAIS – BOCA DO INFERNO – CABO DA ROCA – SINTRA – LISBON | 90 KM (B)**

Depart at 9 a.m. for a panoramic tour of Lisbon, then visit Belém to see iconic landmarks like the Padrão dos Descobrimentos, Jerónimos Monastery, and Belém Tower. Enjoy a stop at the famous Belém pastry factory before heading along the coast through Estoril to Cascais, with free time for lunch and a stroll. Continue to Boca do Inferno and Cabo da Roca, then end the day in Sintra with time to explore. Return to Lisbon for overnight accommodation.

**DAY 3 (SUN): LISBON FREE DAY (B)**

Free day for individual activities or optional tours. Overnight in Lisbon.

**DAY 4 (MON): LISBON – ÓBIDOS – NAZARÉ – ALCOBAÇA – FÁTIMA | 112 MILES (B)**

Depart at 9 a.m. for Óbidos, a charming village of narrow streets and flower-lined white houses, with time to taste the traditional Ginja. Continue to Nazaré, a fishing town famous for its giant waves, with free time for lunch and a stroll. Then visit Alcobaca to see the tombs of D. Pedro I and D. Inês de Castro at the UNESCO-listed monastery, and enjoy tasting traditional convent sweets. Arrive in Fátima for free time and overnight accommodation.

Important: Between April and October, there is the possibility of participating in the candle procession.

**DAY 5 (TUE): FÁTIMA – ALJUSTREL – COIMBRA – PORTO | 210 KM (B)**

Departure at 9 a.m. for Coimbra, with a brief stop in Aljustrel, where the three shepherd children lived, including a visit to Sister Lucia's house. Upon arrival in Coimbra, visit the University of Coimbra and the Joanina Library, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Free time for lunch and a stroll through the historic center of Coimbra. Transfer to the train station and departure for Porto (Campanhã station). Reception by the driver and transfer to the hotel. Arrival in Porto, accommodation, and free time.

Important: Passengers are responsible for transporting their luggage between Coimbra and Porto, as no assistance is available on this route. Upon arrival at Porto station, look for the driver at the main exit—he will be holding a sign with your name on it. If you exit through another door, you can find him in the main hall of the station.

**DAY 6 (WED): PORTO FREE DAY (B)**

Day is free day for individual activities or optional tours. Overnight accommodation in Porto.

**DAY 7 (THU): PORTO – SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA | 231 KM (B)**

Depart at 9:00 a.m. for Santiago de Compostela, the final stop of the Camino de Santiago. Enjoy free time for lunch, then visit the Cathedral, where St. James is believed to be buried. Afterwards, explore the historic center at your leisure, including its charming streets and iconic squares, with an optional visit to the Museum of Pilgrimages. Overnight accommodation in Santiago de Compostela.

**DAY 8 (FRI): SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA – COMBARRO – PORTO | 250 KM (B)**

Depart at 11 a.m. for Porto, with free time in the morning to attend mass at the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela or enjoy the city. En route, stop in the fishing village of Combarro, known for its stone houses, seaside granaries, and charming narrow streets, with free time for lunch and a stroll. Arrive back in Porto, accommodation, and free time.

**DAY 9 (SAT): DEPARTURE PORTO (B)**

Whole day is free until time to transfer to the airport for departure.

**NOTES:**

1. This tour requires a minimum of 2 passengers to operate and maximum group size of 8 passengers.
2. The minimum age allowed to join this guaranteed small group series is 4 years old. Children below 4 years old will be accepted only on private tours
