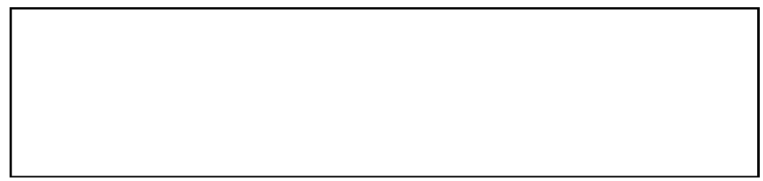

DAY 1: ARRIVE IN AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS (D)

Welcome to Amsterdam, a city of canals, bicycles, and calm reflections. After check-in, explore at your own pace.

DAY 2: AMSTERDAM DISCOVERY (B)

A guided canal cruise introduces Amsterdam from its most intimate angle at water level. Visit a diamond workshop and enjoy the afternoon for independent wandering.

DAY 3: AMSTERDAM – RHINELAND, GERMANY (B)

Cross into Germany for a scenic drive along the Rhine. Optional cruise available for those who want to see the Lorelei Rock and vine-clad hills from the water.

DAY 4: RHINELAND - NEUSCHWANSTEIN - INNSBRUCK REGION, AUSTRIA (B, D)

Travel south to view King Ludwig's iconic Neuschwanstein Castle. Continue toward the Austrian Tyrol for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5: INNSBRUCK REGION - VENICE AREA, ITALY (B, D)

Cross into Italy. Glide by boat to St. Mark's Square, admire Venetian palaces, and watch artisans craft delicate glasswork.

DAY 6: VENICE AREA - ASSISI - ROME (B)

Travel south into Umbria to Assisi. Visit the Basilica. Continue to Rome for the night.

DAY 7: ROME: THE ETERNAL CITY (B)

Begin at St. Peter's Square with a local guide, then journey through Rome's layered history: ancient walls, the Tiber River, the Baths of Caracalla, and the mighty Colosseum.

DAY 8: ROME - PISA - PISTOIA (TUSCANY) (B, D)

Travel north to Pisa and visit the Square of Miracles with its iconic Leaning Tower. Continue to Pistoia.

DAY 9: PISTOIA - FLORENCE - LAKE COMO (B)

Explore Florence on a guided walking tour: Santa Croce, Piazza della Signoria, Palazzo Vecchio, the Duomo, and the Gates of Paradise. Later, travel north across the Apennines to Lake Como.

DAY 10: LAKE COMO - LUGANO, SWITZERLAND - LUCERNE REGION (B)

Depart Lake Como for Lugano's lakeside charm. Continue into Switzerland via the Gotthard Tunnel and arrive in the Lucerne region.

DAY 11: LUCERNE - INTERLAKEN - LAUSANNE (B)

Explore Lucerne's Old Town and Chapel Bridge, then travel to Interlaken and along Lake Thun before reaching Lausanne overlooking Lake Geneva.

DAY 12: LAUSANNE - BEAUNE - PARIS, FRANCE (B)

Cross Burgundy's vineyards to the medieval town of Beaune. Continue to Paris.

DAY 13: PARIS: CITY OF LIGHT (B)

Discover Paris with a local specialist, exploring its grand avenues, bridges, and landmarks that shaped art and romance for centuries.

DAY 14: DEPARTURE PARIS (B)

Your continental journey concludes after breakfast.
