The tour will lead you through Nordic cities: Copenhagen, Aarhus, Stavanger, Bergen, Oslo, Karlstad and Stockholm to explore beautiful nature, fjords, waterfalls, mountains and lakes. A tour leader will accompany you along the entire route all the way from Copenhagen to Stockholm. Don't worry about having any vouchers for the hotels or trains, these will be taken care of, so you can sit back, relax, and enjoy the ride!

### **DAY 1: ARRIVAL TO COPENHAGEN (B)**

Arrive in Copenhagen, meet your tour leader at the hotel reception, and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure in the Danish capital.

### **DAY 2: COPENHAGEN – AARHUS (B)**

A local guide will take you on a panoramic tour of Copenhagen. You'll see the city's old architecture, the famous Nyhavn district (optional classic canal tour), Amalienborg Palace, Christiansborg Palace (home of the Danish Parliament), the old Stock Exchange, the National Museum, and finish at one of Copenhagen's icons, the Little Mermaid statue.

### **DAY 3: AARHUS – FJORD LINE (B)**

In the morning historical tour with local guide through Aarhus; This is the second most populous city in Denmark and was named the European Capital of Culture in 2017. Its strategic location made it an important Viking city, and later a flourishing commercial place. Stop at the Romanesque-Gothic Cathedral. Free time to continue discovering the city on your own. Afterwards continue to North of Denmark to reach Hirtshals for an overnight cruise to Norway

### **DAY 4: STAVANGER – PULPIT ROCK (B)**

Arrive in Stavanger, take a panoramic walk of the charming old town, and spend the afternoon at leisure with an option for a 3-hour cruise on the Lysefjord and/or climb the Pulpit Rock (Preikestolen) from the fjord to the mountaintop.

\*Travellers choosing Option B will not take the morning tour of Stavanger). Please note only one option can be selected.

### **DAY 5: STAVANGER – BERGEN (B)**

Continue driving to Bergen by taking ferry from Mortavika to Årsvågen and from Sandvikvåg to Halhjem. Arrival in Bergen and free time for lunch. In the afternoon, panoramic tour of Bergen to see the most emblematic places of the city, including the famous fish market and the Hanseatic quarter.

### **DAY 6: BERGEN – FLAM – BALESTRAND (B)**

After breakfast we are heading to Voss to start our spectacular train trip. In Myrdal, board the famous Flam Railway Flåmsbana - one of the steepest trainlines in the world. The train journey runs through fantastic nature, past the Rallar road, steep mountains, breath-taking waterfalls and no less than 20 tunnels. Enjoy some leisure time upon arrival in Flåm. Take a cruise on the Sognefjord to Balestrand for our accommodation.

### **DAY 7: BALESTRAND – BORGUND CHURCH – OSLO (B)**

Drive through mountains and valleys, stopping to visit the wooden Borgund Church, before continuing to Oslo.

### **DAY 8: OSLO – VIGELAND PARK – KARLSTAD (B)**

Guided tour of Oslo including Frogner Park with the Vigeland sculpture complex, passing the City Hall, the Royal Palace, and the modern Opera. Free time for lunch. Depart Sweden to Karlstad for next journey.

### **DAY 9: KARLSTAD – STOCKHOLM (B)**

Drive east to Stockholm, where you will take a panoramic guided tour of the Swedish capital, Surrounded by the Lake Mälaren and the Baltic Sea, with its grand public buildings, palaces, rich cultural history and museums tell its beautiful 700-year history. Visit the Old Town ("Gamla Stan") and take a viewing of the Royal Palace, the Cathedral and Parliament.

### **DAY 10: DEPARTURE**

The tour ends after breakfast, and you will transfer to the airport on your own for your departure. Optional Royal Canal Tour.

**N.B. The minimum age allowed to join this tour is 8 years old!**

### **INCLUSIONS:**

- Eight (8) nights hotel accommodation at listed hotels or similar.
- One (1) night onboard a cruise (seaview cabin with twin beds);
- 8 breakfasts + 2 dinners.
- Use of long-distance coach for 8 days.
- Cruise on the Sognefjord & Aurlandsfjord from Flam to Balestrand.
- Panoramic train from Myrdal to Flam.
- Bergen railway train from Voss to Myrdal.
- Ferry Odden-Aarhus; Mortavika-Arsvagen; Sandvikvåg-Arsvgen; Dragsvik-Hella and Manheller-Fodnes.
- 3 hours sightseeing tour in Copenhagen by bus with English-speaking guide.
- 2 hours sightseeing tour in Aarhus by bus with English-speaking guide.
- 2 hours walking tour in Bergen with English-speaking guide.
- 3 hours tour in Oslo by bus with English-speaking guide.
- 3 hours bus tour in Stockholm by bus with English-speaking guide.
- Services of an English-speaking escort from Day 1 to Day 10.
