



# GUIDED ICELAND CIRCLE TOUR: THE BEST OF ICELAND

## 8 DAYS - 7 NIGHTS

### 2026 DEPARTURES

May 8, 22; Jun. 5, 19; Jul. 3, 17, 31; Aug. 14

Embark on an 8-day guided tour of Iceland's natural wonders. Begin in Reykjavik, heading north to see the Grábrók volcano and the Glaumbær turf houses. Spend a night in Akureyri and visit Goðafoss waterfall. Explore Lake Mývatn (lava formations, pseudo craters) and relax at the Mývatn Nature Baths. Continue through the Námaskarð hot spring area to the East Fjords. Witness the Vatnajökull glacier, taking a boat tour on Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon and Diamond Beach. Travel the South Coast to experience the Lava Show, Skógafoss, Seljalandsfoss, and Reynisfjara black sand beach. The final day covers the Golden Circle: Friðheimar (greenhouse/horses), the erupting Strokkur, Gullfoss, and Þingvellir National Park, concluding with a short tour of Reykjavik.

#### **DAY 1: ARRIVAL**

Individual transfer by Flybus shuttle bus from Keflavik airport to your accommodation in Reykjavik. You may explore Iceland's capital city on your own if time allows

#### **DAY 2: VOLCANO CRATER, FJORDS & MOUNTAINS (B, D)**

Depart Reykjavik at 09:00, heading west to hike the Grábrók volcano crater. Visit the beautiful Glaumbær turf house museum. Continue through scenic fjords to Akureyri, the Capital of North Iceland, with time to explore the town upon arrival.

#### **DAY 3: THE CAPITAL OF NORTH ICELAND, LAKE MÝVATN & GEOTHERMAL BATHS (B)**

At 09:00, meet your guide and depart Reykjavik, traveling west to Borgarnes. Enjoy an easy hike on the Grábrók volcano crater. Further north, visit Glaumbær, one of Iceland's most beautiful turf house farms and folk museums. Continue along scenic fjords and over mountain passes to Akureyri, the Capital of North Iceland, with time to walk around and explore the beautiful town.

#### **DAY 4: LAVA LABYRINTH, HOT SPRINGS & TRAVEL EAST (B)**

In the morning, walk in the lava labyrinth of Dimmuborgir ("the dark castles"). In the afternoon, visit the hot spring area of Námaskarð, with its bubbling mud pools and steaming solfataras. Head through the uninhabited highlands to East Iceland. From June to August, the tour includes a detour to the powerful Dettifoss waterfall.

#### **DAY 5: EAST FJORDS, GLACIER LAGOON & DIAMOND BEACH (B)**

Admire the dramatic fjord landscapes and fishing villages of the East Fjords. View Vatnajökull, Europe's largest glacier. End the day at Jökulsárlón glacial lagoon. A boat tour between floating icebergs is included from May to October. You can walk on the black sandy beach (The Diamond Beach) where large icebergs get stranded.

#### **DAY 6: VATNAJÖKULL NATIONAL PARK & SOUTH COAST (B)**

Travel along the southern part of Vatnajökull, catching a glimpse of the national park, mountains, and glacier. The scenic drive continues across the Eldhraun lava field and the south coast desert. Experience the unique Icelandic Lava Show. Stroll along Reynisfjara black sand beach near Vík. Visit the impressive Skógafoss waterfall, and continue to Seljalandsfoss, where an exciting trail goes behind the falls.

#### **DAY 7: ICELANDIC HORSES & GOLDEN CIRCLE (B)**

Explore the Golden Circle: Start at Friðheimar (Icelandic horse and geothermal greenhouse). Visit the Geysir geothermal fields to see Strokkur erupt. See Gullfoss ("the golden falls"), a powerful double waterfall. Conclude the circuit at Thingvellir National Park (UNESCO site). Return to Reykjavik for a short city tour of the capital's highlights.

#### **DAY 8: DEPARTURE (B)**

Individual transfer by Flybus shuttle bus from your accommodation in Reykjavik to Keflavik International Airport.

#### **INCLUSIONS:**

- Airport arrival & departure transfer by Flybus Shuttle (no guide)
- Seven (7) nights hotel accommodation.
- 7x breakfast + 1x dinner.
- 6 days escorted bus tour with English-speaking guide/driver-guide.
- Entrance to Glaumbær Folk Museum.
- Entrance to Mývatn Nature Baths including towel.
- Entrance to Stone Museum.
- Amphibian boat tour on Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon (May-Sept depending on weather conditions).
- Icelandic Lava Show.
- Icelandic horse stables & geothermal greenhouse.

#### **EXCLUSIONS:**

- Any private expenses
- Any additional services
- All meals not listed under "included"
- Single supplement (mandatory when in a single room)
